Anastasia, now 9 months old, was diagnosed with B-cell acute lymphoblastic leukemia at age 5 months. She began steroid therapy in Ukraine. She was transferred to our facility for further management approximately three weeks later, and began therapy according to the Interfant-06 protocol.

At this point, Anastasia has been receiving chemotherapy for approximately 4.5 months. She is doing well, with follow-up bone marrow studies in remission. Her disease has been classified as medium-risk. This indicates that she will continue chemotherapy according to the Interfant protocol, requiring approximately 3 more months of intensive IV therapy and later transferring to extended oral maintenance therapy until approximately 2 years from diagnosis. Anastasia's care includes many follow-up clinic visits and supportive care including blood product transfusions.

Anastasia's response to therapy will be reassessed at further time-points and if it is not sufficient, the possibility remains that she will require a hematopoietic stem cell transplant.
